



# NOVA SCOTIA TEACHERS UNION FRENCH LANGUAGE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT

## INFORMATION SHEET

### **Purpose:**

At the April Provincial Executive meeting, a new grant opportunity was realized to support attendance at **French language conferences for Francophone members and members who teach in the French language. The total annual amount for this grant is three-thousand five hundred (\$3500).**

Operational Procedure 26.E. states: French Language Professional Development Grant The NSTU shall support Members who work in French to attend the annual meeting of the Association canadienne d'éducation de langue française (ACELF) or similar professional development conference primarily delivered in the French-language. Funding shall be available up to three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500) to help defray the costs associated with attending such events.

### **Eligibility:**

This Grant shall be prioritized in the following order:

- a. French first-language (CSAP)
- b. French second-language.

### **Application Process:**

1. Applications must address all items, in sequence using **the current version of this form. Typed applications are preferred.** The application form may also be obtained from the NSTU office, your local VP-PD, School Rep.
2. Provide full names on the application in lieu of acronyms.
3. Recipients of Conference Grants are required to submit a typed report to the Professional Development Committee of the NSTU upon completion of the conference. The grant will be paid upon receipt of the report. The report becomes the property of the NSTU and may be made available to the membership through the NSTU Web site.
4. Selection Process:
  - Grants are awarded by the Provincial Executive upon recommendation by the Provincial Professional Development Committee.
  - The PD Committee shall vet applications according to the following criteria:
    - This Grant shall be prioritized in the following order:
      - a. French first-language,
      - b. French second-language.
    - How the conference will support the achievement of your professional learning goals
    - Special consideration may be given to a teacher new to the profession

## 5. Deadlines:

**For this first round only: Applications must be received at the NSTU Central Office on/or before 4:00pm on or before Wednesday, May 20, 2026.**

## 6. Reporting:

Funds will be awarded **upon receipt** of:

- a typed report of the conference to be housed on the NSTU website
- proof of attendance
- Receipts indicating expenses incurred and funding received from other sources. Scanned copies of original receipts are acceptable if originals are required through Article 60.
