- As per Article 27.08(i) of the TPA "Notwithstanding 27.06, if a probationary or permanent contract teacher requests parental leave at the time
 of request for pregnancy leave, and if the teacher is in receipt of a pregnancy or parental allowance during the summer, then the pregnancy
 and parental allowance beginning with the first non-teaching day in the summer shall be deferred to commence on the first day of the teaching
 period in the school year. For greater certainty, a teacher cannot receive more than seventeen (17) weeks leave of absence for pregnancy
 and more than sixty-one (61) weeks parental leave for a maximum of seventy-eight (78) weeks."
- No teacher can receive more than a total of 17 weeks of combined pregnancy and parental allowance.
- Parental allowance is based on the standard EI parental benefit even if the teacher elects the extended EI parental benefit.
- Pregnancy leave can start at any time from a day eleven (11) weeks before the specified date of delivery to the day of actual delivery.
