## Venue Accessibility Questionnaire/Information

The NSTU is working to accommodate the needs of our members attending NSTU events. This venue questionnaire aims to ensure that our organization can make every reasonable effort to address a range of accessibility needs so that as many participants as possible can be informed of potential limitations. The NSTU is requesting that prospective venues complete the following questions to help us assess and inform members on event accessibility.

### 1. Venue Information

### 2. Accessibility Information

#### 1. **Building Access & Infrastructure:**

- Does the venue have ramps or elevators for building entry?
- Are there any steps or barriers at the building entrance?
- Are the rooms the NSTU would use accessible via elevator and/or ramp?

#### 2. **Restrooms:**

- Are there accessible restrooms available?
- Are there all-gender restrooms?

#### 3. **Seating and Pathways:**

- Is there wheelchair/mobility aid-accessible seating?
- Are pathways (and doorways) clear and wide enough for mobility aids?

#### 4. **Audio and Visual:**

- Does the venue have a functioning audio system?
- Is the audio system capable of being adjusted?
- Does the venue have functioning and fully reliable wifi and/or wired internet?
- Is the lighting system capable of being adjusted (dimmed)?

### Additional Information

Are there any additional accessibility features or considerations/information not covered in the above questions?

We have fully accessible guest rooms for those with mobility aids and also those with hearing impairments. Our accessible guest rooms have full roll-in capabilities including, but not limited to the shower, the sink, the bed space. The doors have both mid-door and bottom of door height buttons for ease of access into the rooms.

The two gendered bathrooms and the one non-gendered bathroom all have wheel-in access for use with mobility aids. Strobe lights are installed in the event space to assist in alerting individuals with hearing impairments during an emergency.
