To identify trends, issues, and problems pertaining to French as a first language; 4. To review current developments and to examine reports and briefs pertaining to French as a first language and to make recommendations to the Executive Committee on actions and response; 5. To advise the Executive Committee on the value of activities which would help to accomplish the CTF/FCE Policy and objectives in the area of French-language services; 6. To identify strategies by which the CTF/FCE can be an advocate to promote and support the Francophonie; 7. To support the CTF/FCE in broadening awareness and building commitment regarding French-language services; 8. To identify strategies by which the CTF/FCE can promote and support teaching as a career for Francophones; 9. To make recommendations to the Executive Committee regarding the CTF/FCE Policy on Francophonie and suggest modifications as appropriate; 10. To participate through its Chairperson in the CTF/FCE delegation attending the meetings of the Conférence des associations francophones en éducation (Conference of Francophone Educational Associations); and to have its Chairperson help the CTF/FCE President, at his or her invitation, appoint other members of the delegation.
