Keys To Effective Policy

stated purpose

updated regularly

clear wording

- · successfully implemented
- (KISS Keep it Short and Simple)
- stated in the positive

Definition/Categorization

POLICY — states position

PROCEDURE — tells how

Common Pitfalls

- inconsistent
- too long
- too general
- unenforceable

- does not reflect view of the majority
- outdated

Writing Technique (The Fog Index)

- 25 words or less per sentence
- 75 words or less per paragraph
- 12 words or less per punctuated clause
- 200 syllables or less per 100 words

of writing should be composed of one and two syllable words.
