2. **Approved recommendations from the Table Officers; including:**
 - (i) **amended Standing Orders regarding CTF Delegates**
 - (ii) **revised three Executive Meeting dates for 2007-08 and one for 2008-09;**
 - (iii) **selected two candidates for the new NSTU Mentorship Program**
 - (iv) **selected four candidates and two alternates for the John Huntley Memorial Internship Program**
 - (v) **selected the Council Nominating Committee and Council Steering Committee for Annual Council 2007**
 - (vi) **approved guidelines for Council Hospitality Suites**
 - (vii) **nominated Mary-Lou Donnelly as a candidate for Vice President of the Canadian Teachers' Federation**

4. **Approved the hiring of an NSTU Financial Officer as of August 1, 2007 at the Intermediate Staff level**
