

NSTU Provincial Executive Meeting January 18-19, 2007 H I G H L I G H T S Emailed Monday, January 22, 2007

- 1. Filed the Report from the Table Officers; including the selection of four candidates for the John Huntley Memorial Internship Program
- 2. Amended the list of NSTU Signing Officers
- 3. Amended the wording of the Secondment process, to include additional methods for advertising
- 4. Approved a payment for the Coalition Against Violence in the Workplace
- 5. Approved the following Personnel Committee recommendations:
 - > Approved amendments to the Mentorship Program
 - > Extended current secondment in Professional Services (Eileen Coady) until February 2, 2007
 - Approved a secondment in Professional Services from February 3 June 29, 2007; and approved a secondment in Member Services from February 1 to March 30, 2007;
 - Appointed Bill Redden as Acting Executive Director;
 - > Appointed *Bruce Kelloway* as Acting Assistant Executive Director;
- 6. Approved the following recommendations from the Finance & Property Committee:
 - > Basic services and activities of Locals should be established by the Provincial Executive
 - NSTU budget will include auditing costs for Locals, RRC's and Professional Associations
- 7. Approved a second meeting with representatives from the NSTU and MTA; and that financial guidelines be established for Professional Associations
- 8. Approved three resolutions move forward to Annual Council 2007 from Professional Associations
- Amended four policies and reaffirmed two policies to Council 2007 from the Policy Review Government Section
- 10. Approved Provincial Executive resolutions to Council identify where the proposal originated, i.e. Professional Association, Committee, or RRC;
- 11. Filed the draft audited financial statements, ending July 31, 2006;
- 12. Approved Professional Associations conduct their PreCouncil Vote by conference call
- 13. Granted three Educational Research Awards of \$475. and seven Out-of-Province Conference Grants of \$450.
- 14. Approved a two-day meeting for the Curriculum Committee
