Issues raised by members:

- Students not visible to specialist teachers (i.e. resource).
- <u>DOE Response:</u> Fixed as identified access privileges fixed.
- All students registered for a specific course are grouped together and not separated into sections.
- DOE Response: Fixed.
- Attendance is restricted to three choices (present, late, absent) with no choice to select excused absence.
- <u>DOE Response:</u> Teachers are limited to three choices and the office verifies the reason for absences.
- Teachers are unable to view how students enrolled in their course is doing in other courses they are enrolled in.
- DOE Response: Noted by the Department.
- Professional development has not been sufficient to allow some teachers to feel comfortable using the new system.
- <u>DOE Response:</u> The Department will monitor.
- Student and teacher schedules are not appearing accurate in the system.
- DOE Response: Fixed.
- Not all components of the software and documentation are available in French.
- DOE Response: Contract date April 15, 2011 with a target date December 2010.
- Students are not numbered in the system.
- <u>DOE Response:</u> Department will investigate.
- Timetable does not accurately reflect the school timetable.

- Does not tally attendance days of students.

- Many components not turned on.
- In-services taking place on components that are not yet available.
